In addition to the 27 Kairos participants and 9 Facilitators, our International Services team members are hard at work putting together financial and ministry reports about 2013. Our Outreach Department is pulling together summaries for each of the 70+ teams in the 46 countries where we serve. Our Training Team just finished a marvelous "Launch" (a twoweek course prepping a new batch of fresh missionaries for the nations), and our Mobilization Team just received a grant that will cover much of the cost of visiting 20 Bible College campuses and 20 campus ministries over the next 10 months. And of course, our Prayer, Operations and Personnel group is hard at work developing and maintaining all the infrastructure

necessary to keep all of these efforts firing on every single cylinder.

Frankly, it's enough to inspire action and we hope that's exactly what it can do for the church at large. Team Expansion aspires to be a catalyst, a facilitator, and a helping arm to assist the church in doing what it can do best around the world: reach, teach, transform, and multiply. Last fall, Ron and Deb asked us and another couple to meet with them weekly to do premarital counseling. Because of their long relationship history and the dysfunctional patterns they had been used to, these counseling sessions were very necessary. It is amazing to see the working of God throughout the years and how He has been working to make this family whole again.
