FIELD HIGHLIGHT North Africa by workers serving in a secure location

Almost fifteen years ago, a Muslim girl had a dream. In it, she met three fair-skinned, blue-eyed, light-haired girls. Living in a culture without fair-skinned people, the girl found this strange. Even so, she had the impression that meeting these girls was a good thing, a blessing of some kind. Through the years, she had this dream again. Her mother confirmed that it was good, as did her husband years later.

Last spring, this woman was teaching at a school in the middle east when three blue-eyed girls showed up - a Christian worker and her two daughters. She wondered, "Could these be the ones from the dream?" Then, this past fall, she dreamed the dream again. The next day, her husband received a call from the fair-skinned woman's husband, explaining that they were trying to return to the the country.

The woman was convinced that they were the ones she dreamed of so many times! This woman is very devout - she teaches Qu'ran at the mosque and is covered in black except for two small eye holes. But because of this dream, she is very warm to these Christian workers. Long before the workers were thinking of this country, God was thinking of the people there and softening their hearts. He was preparing this lady for an encounter with Him.
