spend on a variety of activities, by state. It makes for interesting reading.* TV time per day varied by state between 2 hours and 3 hours 38 minutes. Leisure activities averaged between 4 1/2 hours and 6 hours per day. Time spent doing all religious activities (prayer being one of them) hovered between 2 minutes and 17 minutes per day.

We apparently don't pray that much.

Yet Paul commands us to pray "without stopping." And Jesus asked us to pray for harvesters for those who were harassed and helpless. No wonder there are still so many unreached people groups. Would you like to completely skew the Bureau
