SPECIAL FIELD HIGHLIGHT: PHILIPPINES

In the Philippines, a 7.2 earthquake followed shortly by a record-breaking typhoon this month has cost thousands their lives, and more than 9 million people have been affected by the destruction. Team Expansion workers, the Propps, operate an orphanage called Village of Hope in Bohol. While sorting through their own extensive damage and clean-up, the Propps are also equipping and leading teams to reach into the most devastated parts of the Philippines.

Thankfully, IDES has granted \$50,000 for earthquake and typhoon relief, but more is certainly needed.
